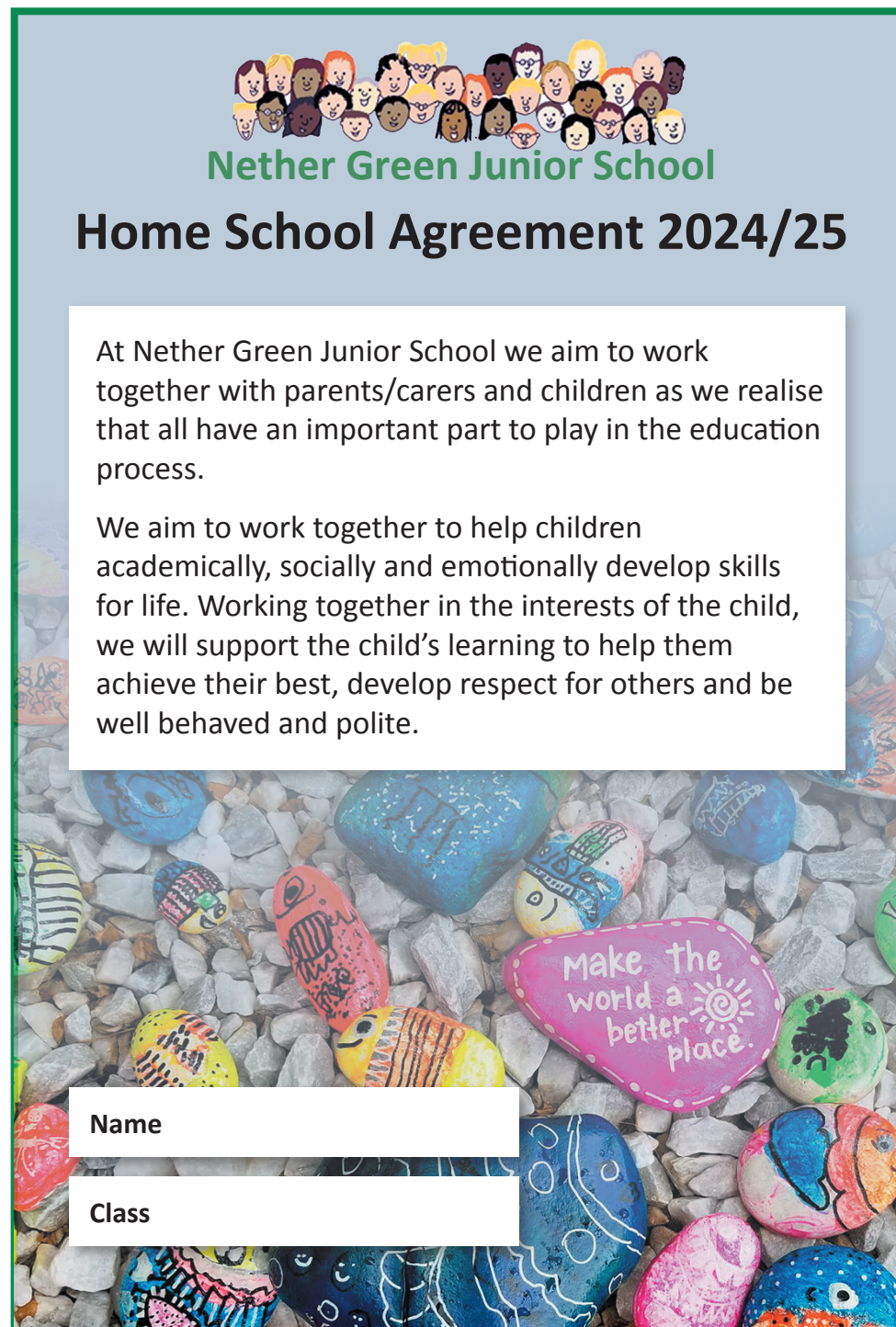
Home School Agreement 2024/25
