PARKING AROUND SCHOOL

Frustratingly, school has received another complaint from a local resident, regarding dangerous and inappropriate parking by a parent/carer of our school.

School staff regularly witness some of our parents/carers parking on double yellow lines, on corners and across people's driveways.

Such parking is not only illegal but is also extremely dangerous. It puts the safety of our children, members of the community and other road users at risk. It also causes inconvenience for local residents who cannot access their driveways.

Dropping your child off on the zig zags, directly outside school, is also extremely dangerous and we would urge parents/carers to park up safely before allowing children to get out of vehicles.

Recently, the police have been taking photographs of cars which are illegally parked. Traffic wardens have also been patrolling and issuing tickets to offenders.

Mr Allen will be contacting the Parking Services Department at the council, to request additional patrols around school.

Please allow ample time at drop off/pick up times, to park your vehicle in a safe, considerate and legal parking space.










