#### Staff

We have a few staffing changes for September, along with new appointments to strengthen and increase the leadership capacity in school.

Miss Dowd and Miss Hilton will be leaving us at the end of the year. Miss Dowd is seeking new opportunities in a different context and capacity. We want to say a huge congratulations to Miss Hilton, who has secured a teaching position in a primary school in Manchester. We wish them both all the best for the future and they will be missed by us all at Nether Green Junior.

Last week we appointed 3 teachers on a permanent basis, one of them being Miss Hawkins, who has been a fantastic addition to the school working in year 4 since January. Our other 2 appointments, Mr Earl and Ms Hopkins, will bring a wealth of experience and are looking forward to joining us for the transitions in the latter part of the summer term and then starting officially in September.

We have appointed two Assistant Headteachers this term, ready to begin their new roles in September. Mrs Charlesworth will be leading Teaching & Learning across school, as well as supporting Early Career Teachers and School Centred Initial Teacher Training students. Ms Musgrove, who will start in September, will lead Personal Development and be our new SENDCo. Ms Musgrove and Mrs Longbottom are already liaising to ensure there is a smooth and thorough handover.

Our new merit reward system in school is well under way and our children have been extremely proud of their successes linked to the 6 core values. Certificates will be handed out in assembly in the first week back after half term to recognise all the great achievements.
