As your child is about to transfer to Nether Green Junior School may I take this opportunity, on behalf of all the staff, to offer your family a most sincere welcome.

We wish to build on the good practice of our feeder schools and in turn offer your child a variety of rich experiences to help them realise their potential.

We are aware that not only is this an exciting time for your child as they grow up to become 'a junior', but it may also be a time when they have worries about moving to a new and much larger school. In order to ensure we provide a smooth transition for your child, we have a well established process in place to ensure you and your child are able to visit the school, meet the teachers, find out about our systems and ask any questions.

Before your child comes to meet their teacher and look around the school, the teachers from the infant schools will allocate the children a place in one of the 3 classes - this is done very carefully and your child's needs and friendship groups are taken into account. The Y3 teachers at our school will also have met with the Y2 teachers at the infant schools so they will have some background information about your child. In addition to this, our Y3 teachers will have visited the Infant schools and worked with your children.

For some identified children additional visits will take place to help them make the transition.

A welcome pack will be sent home with your child on Friday 23rd June. In this you will find a letter confirming which class your child will be in next year. You will also receive some other documentation. This will include: our Home School Agreement, emergency contact/medical form and permission letters. Please fill these in and return them asap to the NGJS office, or at the very latest, please bring to our Family Evening on 4th July at 6pm.

Tuesday 4th July we will be holding our **Y2 Parent/Carer Evening**. This will be an opportunity for parents/carers and their children to visit the school. The evening will begin at 6.00pm with myself speaking a little bit about life at Nether Green Junior School and offer time for parents/carers to meet the Y3 teachers, see the classroom their child will be in when they start in September and ask any questions they may have.
