Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our 'What happened in WWII and how did it affect Sheffield?' project, we have organised a visit to Crich Tramway Village, Derbyshire. The visit will take place on **Thursday 14th March 2024**.

As part of the visit, the children will explore the Home Front during WWII using role play in a session led by the museum staff. The children will have the opportunity to experience what life was like for evacuees and will take part in three workshops. We will be asking for a voluntary contribution of **£23.95** to cover the cost (£12.50 entry to the museum, three workshops, and a tram ride, and £11.45 for coach travel). Included in the cost will be a ration book.

As the day features an evacuee role play activity (which the children will draw upon later in school writing lessons) we are encouraging the children to dress in clothes from the era. Typical clothes for a boy might include: shirt, trousers, woollen jumper. Typical clothes for a girl might include: dress, skirt, shirt, woollen cardigan. The children will be given an evacuee tag, ID card and ration book on the day of the trip as well as the gas mask box that they will have make in school. Please ensure that costumes are appropriate for the weather as we shall be spending a lot of the day outdoors.

The children will be travelling by coach and should arrive in school normal time as we are leaving a 9am. We will return to school at approximately **4.00pm**. Pupils need to bring a packed lunch and drink. They will also need to bring any medication they require on the day, clearly labelled. Please ensure that the school office has your latest contact details and all medical information is up to date. The emergency contact for the visit will be the school office 0114 230 2461. If the visit is unable to go ahead, we shall remain in school and you will be informed.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £23.95 to cover the cost of the experience. If your child qualifies for Pupil Premium no payment is required. Under current legislation we may only seek voluntary contributions. However, without people matching their voluntary contributions to the true cost it can be difficult to organise these events. The school's policy of wishing to help anyone experiencing financial difficulties still exists.

Payment should be made via Parentpay or in cash (sorry, no cheque payments can be accepted). To support the payment of this visit, payments can be made up until Friday 1st March 2024.
