

## **Equipment/Kit List for Residential Visit to Edale**

We request that as many items as possible are named and packed in a clearly named bag which will go in the boot of the coach. Small suitcase with wheels would be ideal. Your child will probably get muddy so don't send any expensive or precious clothing items.

- T shirts
- Trousers x 3
- Jumpers/ fleeces
- Underwear and socks
- Towel, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste etc.
- Small pack of tissues
- Pyjamas
- Outdoor shoes x2
- Indoor shoes – no massive slippers please!
- Hat and gloves
- Small cuddly toy (optional)
- Labelled carrier bag for wet clothes – essential!
- A small rucksack to carry packed lunch
- Packed lunch (please be aware that we have a no nut policy) - for day 1 only
- **Waterproof** coat or kagoule
- Medicines (clearly labelled) which will be handed to the teacher on the morning of departure
- Inhalers (clearly labelled) which will be carried by your child
- A book to read, playing cards, Top Trumps etc... (no electrical devices)

If your child needs travel sickness pills for the outward journey please administer them before coming to school. Medication for the return journey should be clearly labelled, including instructions, and handed to the teacher on the morning of departure.

Please **do not** bring:

- **Any electronic music or game devices**
- **Mobile phones**
- **Sweets or food additional to packed lunch**
