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Life Skills

In our Life Skills work this half term, we will be focusing on; 'How can we make and maintain positive relationships?'

What makes a close friend?

- To understand what it takes to be a good friend.
- To empathise with people who are excluded.

Should friends tell us what to do?

 Understand that friendship is not just about doing what someone says and that boundaries are healthy and an essential part of any relationship

Why are some people unkind?

Identify the reasons why some children bully.

Maths

We will be consolidating and deepening our place value understanding.

We will develop our addition and subtraction skills using both arithmetic and reasoning skills.

Spanish

We will continue to develop our Phonetics. We will look at vocabulary around Seasons.

Computing

We will be creating web pages.

English - Curriculum links to History.

Our class book is "Riddle of the Runes" by Janina Ramirez.

Reading sessions will also include comprehension and skills linked to the History learning. We will use First News to understand current affairs.

Poetry – Classic nonsense poem, The Jumblies, by Edward Lear.

Writing – we will be writing instructions and Sagas linked to our History learning.

<u>**RE**</u> - We will be studying Christianity and answering the question "What does it mean if Christians believe God is holy and loving?"

Science

We will be furthering our scientific enquiry skills through investigations.

We will be looking at the famous scientist - Maggie Adarin Pocock.

History

Our lead question this half term is "Invaders or settlers: How should we remember the Vikings?"

We will develop our understanding of the meaning of invasion in the context of the Vikings.

Music

This half term we will be singing Viking saga songs.

<u>**PE**</u> - We will be studying Dance and Netball as well as developing our Cross-Country skills.

<u>Art</u> - We will complete a study of Arts & Crafts and develop practical skills in drawing and sculpture.

We will study arts and crafts artists William Morris and May Morris.
