Y4 Aqua Fest Ponds Forge - Tuesday 25th February

Dear Parent /Carer,

As part of our swimming programme, 12 children in Y4 have an opportunity to participate in an Aqua Fest event. The children will participate in a range of fun races suited to their swimming ability and compete against other Sheffield Primary Schools. The visit will be led by Mr Hancock.

This event will be held at Ponds Forge on Tuesday 25th February from 1 – 3pm. The children will be travelling by minibus to the event, leaving school at 12pm and returning just after the end of the school day at 3.45pm.

On this day, the children will need to arrive to school **swim ready** (swimming kit under their normal clothes) and also bring their goggles/towel to school. They will also need to bring any extra clothes to change back into once the event has finished. With the minibus picking us up at 12.00pm, the children will eat their lunch (school dinners or packed lunch) at 11.45am in the school's dining hall before leaving to Ponds Forge. It is advised that you pack your child with a drinks bottle and an extra snack for them to have during the event.

Children should ensure they are dressed appropriately for the weather and will also need to bring any medication they require for the day, clearly labelled. Please ensure that the school office has your latest contact details and all medical information is up to date. There is no charge for your child to participate in this event.

If the visit is unable to go ahead, we will let you know on the morning of the visit. Please note your child may be photographed as part of the visit and their photo used to promote the event possibly on the school website or to celebrate back in school. If you do not wish your child to be photographed, please inform us via Parent Pay.

To give permission for your child to take part and give photo consent please complete details on ParentPay by Friday 14th February. This will help us if we need to select a replacement for your child.

This promises to be a really exciting event, and I hope your child enjoys representing their school in this competition.
