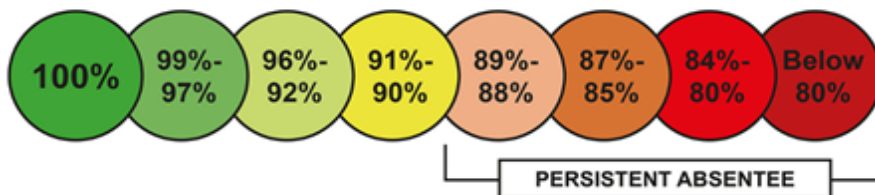


Attendance

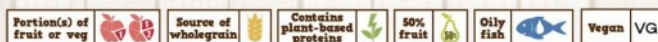
