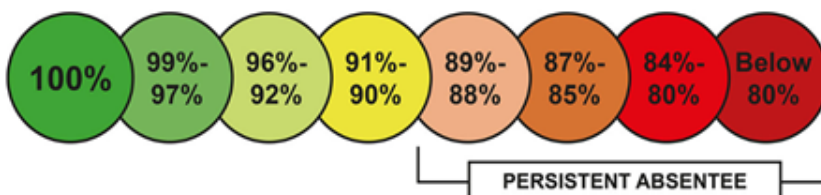


### Attendance

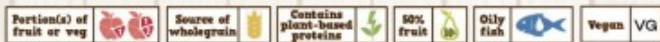
