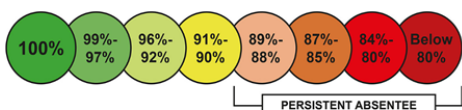

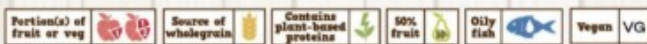

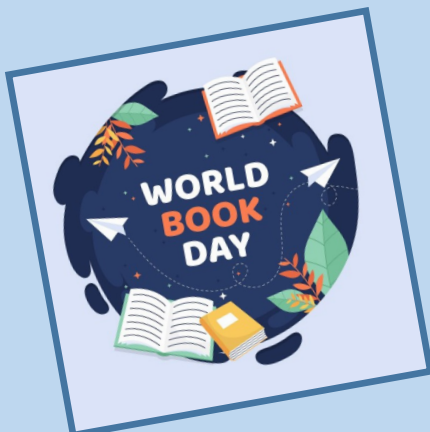
Please note there will be a menu change on Thursday, 5th March for World Book Day. The menu options will be:
