



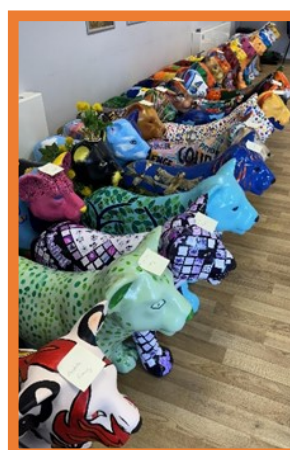
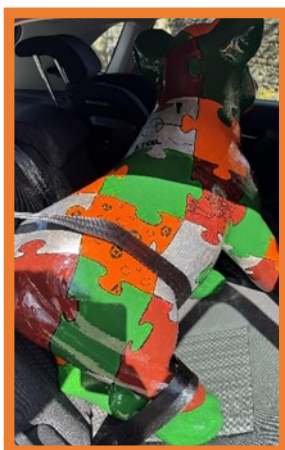
## Message from the Headteacher

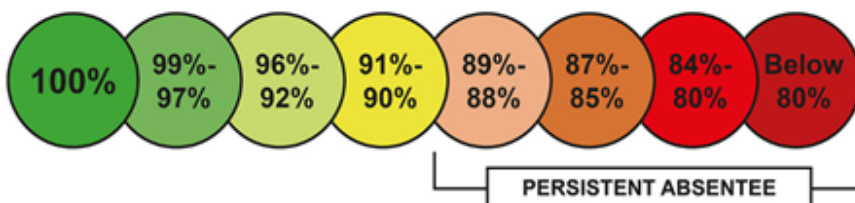
Well done also to Lilia (Y5BB) for winning 3 medals in swimming and to Eleonore and Annabelle for doing so well in their 3.5KM running race.

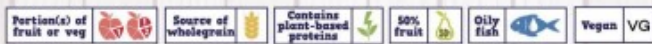

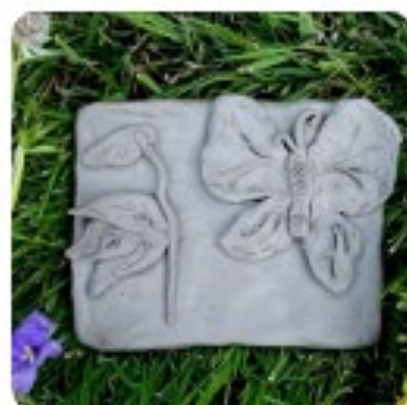
