As this is an evening event, you will be responsible for taking your child to and from the venue. **Mr Hancock and Mr Lomas will be the school representatives at the competition and will meet you in the main entrance hall at 6.15pm.** Please ensure that you arrive on time as the children will need to be changed and ready by the poolside at 6.45pm.

Please ensure that your child arrives at the venue **swim ready** (swimming kit under their normal clothes) and also bring their towel and goggles in a bag. They will also need to bring any extra clothes to change back into once the event has finished. It is advised that you pack your child with a drink and an extra snack for them to have during any periods when they are not swimming.

Families and any other spectators are allowed to watch the races. Once you have left your child with Mr Hancock and Mr Lomas you will be able to make your way up to the balcony entrance where a Malin Bridge Primary School staff member will be selling spectator tickets at £2.00 each and issuing programs.

Please note your child may be photographed as part of the event and their photo used to promote the event possibly on the internet or celebrate back in school. If you do not wish your child to be photographed, please inform us when you give consent on parent pay.
