Percentage of children reaching the expected standard

Area	Nether Green Junior School (%)	National 2026 (%)
Reading	84.2%	75%
Writing	76.8%	73%
Maths	76.8%	75%
SPaG	86.3%	74%
Combined (Reading, Writing & Maths)	70%	63%

"Combined" shows the percentage of children who reached the expected standard in all three of Reading, Writing and Maths together — this is the key national headline figure used to compare schools.

Scaled scores range from 80 to 120. A score of 100 or more means a child is working at the expected standard for Year 6; a score of 110 or more places a child within Greater Depth. These figures show the average scaled score across all children in the year group. There is no scaled score for Writing, as it is assessed by teachers rather than by test.
